Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

Background

This is Gazprom Marketing & Trading Retail Limited's ("GMTR") statement on slavery and human trafficking. This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 ("Act") for the financial year ending on 31 December 2020.

GMTR is fully committed to ensuring that GMTR complies with all applicable legal requirements including without limitation the Act.

Our business

GMTR employs over 300 people worldwide and has business operations in the United Kingdom, France and the Netherlands.

GMTR is a subsidiary company of Gazprom Marketing & Trading Limited, forming part of the Gazprom Marketing & Trading Group ("GM&T Group") of companies, and implements all GM&T Group policies.

Our policy on slavery and human trafficking

GMTR fully supports the aims of the Act. Our policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to endeavour to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in our business or supply chain.

Our processes to prevent slavery and human trafficking

GMTR has undertaken the following activities to ensure the prevention of human trafficking:

1. As a member of the GM&T Group, GMTR has maintained, promoted and complied with the GM&T Group Code of Conduct, which requires staff to, amongst other things, uphold GMTR's commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and clearly states the commitment of the GM&T Group and all its subsidiaries to combating modern slavery and human trafficking.
2. Participated in the review and improvement of GM&T Group's global suite of policies and procedures, which require staff to, amongst other things, uphold GMTR's commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships.
3. As a member of the GM&T Group, GMTR benefits from the GM&T Group whistleblowing telephone hotline and web portal to facilitate the making of anonymous whistleblowing reports and appropriate underlying whistleblowing investigation and handling procedures to provide adequate protection for whistleblowers, should anyone wish to make a report related to modern slavery and human trafficking.

As part of our commitment to combating modern slavery, GMTR will be taking the following steps:

1. As a part of a wider group risk assessment, continue a review of the various parts of our business to ensure no slavery or human trafficking takes place in any part of our business or the supply chain.
2. Continue to maintain and promote the GM&T Group Code of Conduct and continue to review and improve our processes and policies to identify how we can try to ensure that no slavery or human trafficking takes place within any part of our business or the supply chain.
3. Incorporating appropriate anti-slavery and human trafficking provisions into our procurement and third party supplier contracts on a risk assessed basis.
4. Monitoring potential risk areas in our supply chain, as part of our periodic business-wide risk assessment.

GMTR will continue to review our procedures in relation to the prevention of slavery and human trafficking in our business and supply chain.
